






4.12 If unemployed, are you enrolled in school or a job training program?




4.13 Has the COVID pandemic affected your employment?




4.14 Goodwill Job Connection










4.16 Job Training at Easterseals of East GA






4.17 Salvation Army Job Skills Training Classes






4.18 Augusta Career Center (GA Dept. Labor)






4.19 One-Stop Career Center (Augusta Tech)








5.1 Do any children under age 5 live in your household?
















6.7 Has anyone in your household ever been diagnosed with COVID-19?








6.25 Christ Community Health (Medical & Dental Clinic, 1226 D'Antignac St)






6.26 St Vincent de Paul Health Clinic (Medical Clinic, 432 8th St)






6.27 Druid Park Community Health Center (1018 Druid Park Ave)






6.28 Women's Health of Augusta (1303 D'Antignac St #2500)










